

May 21st Full Scale Exercise

Central Ohio Region Healthcare Coalition

What: The Central Ohio Trauma System and the Central Region Healthcare Coalition are conducting a Full Scale Exercise. This exercise will provide an opportunity for the Central Ohio Healthcare Coalition and regional hospitals to evaluate their emergency operations plans by responding to a simulated pandemic influenza incident. Volunteer actors play an important role in exercises and help provide as close to real world situations as possible. Volunteers will be processed as victims at each healthcare facility to test surge planning. Volunteers will convene at the Vineyard Church in Westerville to be registered and assigned a hospital.

From the Vineyard, volunteers will be transported via COTA busses to participating hospitals and healthcare facilities.

When: May 21st, 2015 at 7am till approx. 1-2pm

Where: All volunteers will report to Vineyard Columbus 6000 Cooper Rd., Westerville, Ohio

Who: Volunteers must be 18 or older.
